Comments	Response
Discussion forum can be put as mandatory so we have more people in the group, thus having more ideas	It is agreed that more participants would be better, and the discussion forum is a mandatory part of the course, but if people do not sign up, then they cannot participate in the discussion forum. It is the lack of registration that creates this difficulty, not the lack of mandating participation in the forum, once registered.
Lesson 6 is the most technical part. It can be enriched with more real examples and problems in order to provide a deeper insight of the calculations.	This is very true, and each case depends on the sciences involved. The examples in Lesson 6 apply primarily to chemistry, but are relatively generic in that they could be used in an electronics lab as well. This course cannot provide the depth of appreciation of uncertainty of measurement required by an accredited lab – only a taste of the subject.
