My only suggestion would be to maybe include on the quizzes an additional answer box, following the 3 short answer questions, where a user could include any additional questions for the facilitator they had with regard to that section. A way to notify the facilitator that the quiz is ready to be marked through the website may be beneficial as well.	Two good suggestions. Both of these facilities are on the current E-learning site, but they are not well done. The new site, currently being designed, has these two suggestions as part of the design criteria. It should be up before the middle of January 2013.
Online course is tougher than the classroom course because online course requires more concentration. Also there is no opportunity for face to face discussion with the facilitator as well as with other participants.	This is very true and these are the standard drawbacks to online training. Time and distance (therefore cost) is always an issue until an opportunity for an in-class session can be made available. In-class sessions overcome both of these impediments to learning.
The course was fine, but I felt a little lonely (sometimes) in front of my screen. The discussion activities proposed at the beginning of each chapter seem very important as a starter and appropriate (especially when you are new in the field), but I understand what online means. Perhaps one day, some discussions could be recorded (voices only), and posted as additional material?	This is the one very great drawback to online training. There is no shared component to experiential learning in this case. However, this participant, and all others, will always have the opportunity to discuss issues with the facilitator, long after the course is complete.
